- Implemented in Delaware on the 11th of February 2022
- No part of assets or net earnings shall be used for purposes that shall not be charitable under sections 501 and 170 of the “Internal Revenue Code”.
- Governing body: Board of Directors
- Personal Liability: Eliminated to the extent permitted by the General Corporation Law of Delaware (DGCL)
